A Refuge for Survivors Amidst a Housing Crisis

Recently the City and County of San Francisco released their homeless count & survey. Many of us don't need a survey to highlight the fact that homelessness in San Francisco is pervasive.

The City's "Point-in-Time" count was conducted on January 24, 2019 and covered the entire city. The study found that 8,011 people were experiencing homelessness in San Francisco.

which is a 17% increase from 2017. The study found that homelessness has also disproportionately impacted the Black and African American community, with 37% of respondents identifying as Black or African American. This is especially striking given that in 2019 the San Francisco General Population Estimate of the Black or African American community sits at 6%.

The study also notes domestic/partner violence as a primary cause of homelessness. We accept hundreds of victims and survivors of domestic violence into our shelter each year to ensure that they do not have to choose between living on the street, or living in fear. Domestic violence is extremely prevalent within the homeless population in San Francisco. Nearly a third of all respondents (31%) reported experiencing domestic/partner violence in their lifetime. 44% of female respondents and 74% of transgender respondents reported experiencing domestic violence across their lifetime.



La Casa has worked tirelessly to be a part of the solution to homelessness for women and children and San Francisco.

Overall we saw a 5% rise from the 2017 Point-in-Time count with regard to individuals who reported experiencing domestic violence in their lifetime, and amongst females we saw the number of respondents impacted by domestic violence increased by 7% from 2017 to 2019.

While these statistics are both disheartening and alarming, one statistic stood out as a reason for hope and a signaling of change. In 2017, of the individuals in families,30% of those in families who had experienced domestic violence reported domestic violence was the primary cause of their homelessness. In 2019, 22% of respondents in this cohort attributed their homelessness to domestic violence. This is a key statistic that La Casa has been working to change. We work each day to prevent homelessness by intervening in the cycles of domestic

Dear Friends of La Casa,

Our Board consists of 12 fierce advocates for survivors of domestic violence. Maria Bee has been a leader and President of this dedicated group of individuals. While we will miss her deeply, we look forward to watching her continue to change the world through her work as Oakland's Chief Assistant City Attorney.

We also welcome Michelle Zauss as the new President of the Board. Michelle is a Senior Director of Sales Strategy and Operations at Salesforce. Michelle joined La Casa's Board of Directors in 2010. Since the day she joined, Michelle has brought immense energy, insight and enthusiasm to our small-but-mighty organization. Chairing the Finance Committee for the past several years, Michelle has helped us strengthen our financial position, and the services that we can provide. She has overseen La Casa's financial decision to pay off the note on our shelter property far ahead of the due date as well as the more recent purchase of our Drop in Counseling Center. Her stewardship, in addition to her passion for ending domestic violence, has always stood out. As a leader in the fight against domestic violence, we are excited to be led by Michelle's spirit and wisdom in the coming years.

I hope you will join me in wishing Maria great success in her future endeavors, and thanking her for the years of service and dedication which she has poured into La Casa.

violence sooner. Our programs are built to intervene in high-risk cases at critical community touchpoints. The sooner we reach individuals in the community, the easier it is to find them other options and support systems, before their domestic violence causes them to become homeless.

At La Casa we talk about seedplanting. Not every survivor we meet at Zuckerberg San Francisco General Hospital, the San Francisco Police Department, the Human Services Agency or the SF Housing Authority wants to work with our co-located advocates right away. What we see however, is survivors coming to our Drop in Center, or calling our hotline, a few days later, seeking the support and services that we offer. It can be frightening to admit you are in an unsafe relationship, and even more frightening to come forward to begin to plan ways to leave an abusive partner.

La Casa's hub and spoke model, in addition to our robust community education and outreach program, are designed to reach as many survivors as possible, before homelessness becomes a reality. With the support of many generous donors, and strong partnerships with goverment agencies, we are able to expand the scope of our response intervention services and walk alongside survivors on their path away from abuse. While it might not be a linear progression, we are proud to be a part of reducing family homelessness caused by domestic violence.
